

## NAVARRE BEACH MARINE SANCTUARY MINUTES 7/26/2010

Meeting Started – 6:05PM

1. Update on Foundation re-organization - Nancy and Mike explained Chamber Foundation now has a Board of Directors completely separate from Chamber Board of Directors. Currently the Marine Sanctuary is the only Foundation committee.

Marine Sanctuary received \$750 check from Navarre Chamber from 2010 Fun Fest 5K profits.

Mike presented Marine Sanctuary profit and loss - Net income \$6171.78

2. Permit update - Mark

Pensacola Reefs have permits in hand. While oil spill has pushed permit process back, we are still projected to receive permits in time frame outline in the 2010 Impact100 grant.

Need to determine dimension and design of signs as well as how plaques will be arranged before officially rolling out the sponsorship plan.
